INCLUDE THE BABY stalked the pace, assumed command mid stretch, drew off and was ridden out. SIXTYSIX MARGAUX vied two wide to the turn, inched clear, led to mid stretch but was no match late. NOTIS HER came out at the start, was never far off the pace, swung wide entering the stretch and got up for show. QUINNETTE was away well, lagged outside, swung wide leaving the turn and lacked a rally. MEETMEAT TIFFANYS vied inside to the turn, fell back and faded through the stretch. HOT ON TOP was crowded at the start, advanced inside to get within striking distance, bid and hung. CANT TOPPER was crowded at the start, raced wide early, dropped inside on the turn and lacked a bid.
