TENATIOUS was unhurried early, went six wide in the drive, got up late under steady urging and was all out at the wire. TONY THE PONY raced close to the pace between horses, rallied through traffic and was outfinished in a game effort. ALABAMA RAIN angled out mid stretch to bid seven wide and closed well. AZA raced close to the pace while boxed in to deep stretch and finished with good energy. I'LL TRY pressed the pace, challenged for the lead on the second turn, dueled for the lead and weakened late. CANDI'S TOAST was never far back, bid and hung. GRANDPA ROY set a pressured pace and gave way past the eighth pole. ALWAYS ROYAL fell far back early and offered a mild bid only.
