ILLINOIS PINUP stumbled badly at the start, chased three wide into the turn, raced four wide into the lane and finished willingly. BRITE NAVY set the pace, raced off the rail into the lane and weakened late. LEADING LINE bobbed slightly and away a bit slowly, raced near the rail on the turn and gained some late. APPEALING ZEPHYR broke a bit slowly, chased four wide on the turn, was in the five path entering the lane and tired. TRIXIE P vied for the lead into the turn, saved ground and weakened in the drive. LUCKY THUNDER lacked a rally.
