SMOKIN BADGE alternated for the lead, saved ground and held the advantage through the lane then was outfinished by the top one. ABOUT ME saved ground to the lane, chased and needed more in the drive. HARLEY HART fractious briefly in the gate, raced up close, chased on the final turn and weakened in the drive. VALENTINE TREAT fractious in the gate unseating the rider, vied early then was eased up and taken outside into the backstretch, trailed and raced outside into the lane and lacked a bid when asked. I AIN'T AFRAID outside into the first turn, was hung wide into the backstretch, chased and tired in the drive.
