COOPER'S STORM bumped and was crowded at the start, rallied five wide leaving the turn, closed under left handed urging and got up late. CLEAN ENERGY vied throughout, began to inch away near the sixteenth pole and was outclosed to finish second best. IRONHOUSE vied inside, faltered near the sixteenth pole but held for show. ASTARFORBUSH was slow early, lacked room in the upper stretch, angled in and closed once clear. ANDHERECOMESCJ broke slowly, saved ground and failed to rally. OL'DOGTOWN broke in and bumped at the start, stalked the pace, had nothing left for the drive and hung. WINTER CANYON raced mid pack, went four wide leaving the turn and lacked a bid. MR. CHUCK bumped at the start, stalked the pace to the turn, stopped and was not urged late.
