TOASTIE'S CROWN off well at the break, rated a clear third to the half mile pole, angled out approaching the turn, circled to rally strongly at the five sixteenths pole, came to the pace at the head of the stretch while placed extremely wide, took command at three sixteenths, and drew off through the stretch. ANNE O ' KEEFE broke in mid pack, closed up going to the turn, rallied strongly at five sixteenths, came to the lane along the inside, and raced gamely through the stretch to secure second. CHARLIE WHO broke quickly, established a clear pace, came to the lane in good order, went evenly through the lane, but could not hold off closing rivals. RED DIVA closed up strongly at the five sixteenths pole, but lacked the needed response down the stretch. TORREY PINES passed tired horses in the stretch. KELLIES MOMENT was outrun. SEE YA N RAISE YA vied on the pace, retreated through the turn, and was empty in the lane.
