MALIBU PROSPECT bumped at the start, set a pressured pace to the turn, drew off and held safely while being kept to task. PURR FOR ME bumped at the start, raced inside, bid willingly to earn place and finished second best. CRIMSON DESIGN raced mid pack, went five wide leaving the turn and closed steadily to be along for show. BO HAGEN pressed the pace outside, fell back on the turn and finished evenly. UTAH BEACH pressed the pace to the turn, dropped back and weakened in the drive. AUNT RITA'S TOMCAT bumped at the start and failed to menace in an even effort. COMIC FOOL showed good early speed, bolted on the turn and lost his chance. MEGAMIGO raced outside, lacked a bid and was outrun. R. BEAU flashed speed, fell back and was not urged in the stretch.
