LAKE SAWYER saved ground, advanced along the rail into the turn, eased out, closed willingly, assumed command mid stretch, drew off past the eighth pole and was ridden out. CHALK HILL raced in hand to the second turn, set the pace to mid stretch, was outclosed but held for second. STORMIN AHEAD was never far off the pace, offered a six wide bid to loom a threat but didn't have enough late. STEP ASIDE CLYDE lagged early, went seven wide in the drive and offered a mild bid only. GAMBLER BILL stalked the pace, angled in on the turn, bid inside and came up empty. IN FOR A SONG saved ground, got through along the rail entering the stretch, had little left and failed to menace. JOSHUA'S JOURNEY stalked the pace to the second turn, tired and gave way. ENFORCER raced outside and was not a factor. BELL BLITZ was through early and steadily faded from contention.
