Footnotes

TALE SPINNER saved ground while forwardly placed, was steadied behind a tiring rival nearing the quarter pole, stayed inside and finished well to prevail. ELITE'S DREAM lodged a bid on the final turn and reached the front in the stretch then was outfinished. DR. WATSON set the pace inside then stayed on willingly through the stretch run while not good enough. INTERACTIVE MINING advanced outside on the final turn and lacked the needed stretch response. CEE'S TREASURE saved ground into the far turn and lacked a bid. DEVIL'S SAINT pressed the issue to the far turn and weakened then was not urged late while fading. MENTALIZE well placed early, gave way heading into the far turn and was not urged through the lane. QUEEN'S PARDON showed little. VALIANT FLAME lacked a response. TALE SPINNER WAS DISQUALIFIED AND UNPLACED DUE TO A MEDICATION VIOLATION.
