GRANDPA ROY was unhurried early, rallied around the turn, dueled through the stretch and prevailed in a long drive. MICHAEL THE MAN was never far back, rallied around the turn, dueled through the stretch and was outfinished in a game effort. STEP ASIDE CLYDE raced in the back, went seven wide at the top of the stretch and finished well to earn show. GENTLE AS A BREEZE raced mid pack, rallied around the turn, bid to get within striking distance and hung in the lane. WHERE'S THE REMOTE was blocked and in tight between horses on the second turn, was taken back, angled out and offered a mild bid only. FARMER GILES (IRE) trailed the field, went eight wide at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. LESSON IN DECEIT settled off the pace, had nothing left for the drive and faded through the stretch. F D ICY was sent to the front to vie two across to the second turn, tired and gave way. GO TO THE PULPIT vied inside to the second turn, tired and gave way.
