DOC FITCH took over on the turn then drew off through the lane under vigorous hand urging. WINNERSTORM raced six wide into the lane and earned the place. TEXAS BAD BOY raced just off the rail turning for home and lacked the needed late bid. SUPER SALESMAN lodged a bid outside on the turn, raced five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late response. THRILLER G saved ground and was steadied in a bit tight passing the eighth pole, angled off the rail and lacked the needed bid. RAPID ROBERT broke out, set the early pace inside, raced in the three path into the lane and tired. A P APTITUDE lunged out at the start, chased and raced four wide into the stretch then weakened. MINISTER'S PRAISE saved ground and lacked a rally. IRISH MONARCH raced near the inside on the turn and tired.
