### Footnotes

DESERT LIGHTNING set the pace, drew off leaving the turn and extended his lead under mild urging. PLAY N WIN broke in, stalked the pace inside, awaited room and was in tight leaving the turn, bid inside once clear but was no match for the winner. TELEIOS broke in and bumped at the start, pressed the pace to the turn, weakened but held for show. WILDCAT ENERGY fell back early to trail and improved position in an even effort. FANSAROUNDTHE TURN saved ground, angled out at the top of the lane, lacked a bid and hung in the lane. IRON CHOO CHOO was not a factor. PROMISE KEEPER bumped at the start, raced close to the pace early and steadily faded from contention.
