B'S LUCKY STRIKE raced outside, rallied around the turn, closed steadily to wear down his rivals and got up late. GOLDEN MINUET set a pressured pace to the final strides and was outfinished in a game effort. JAKY BOY raced between horses to the turn, went willingly to the wire, couldn't gain ground but got up late for show. CASE SETTLED raced mid pack in a steady effort but didn't have enough late. BRITBURG pressed the pace inside, yielded near the sixteenth pole and fell back. SHILOH'S PAC BOOM raced close to the pace along the rail, angled out on the turn, had nothing left and hung. DOC FITCH stumbled at the start, showed good early speed, was taken back and not urged in a wide trip.
