ROBO WILLIE advanced to the turn to challenge for the lead, dueled to deep stretch and inched clear to prove best. YES TALK TO ME was away alertly to set the pace with a clear lead to the turn, responded when challenged to duel to deep stretch but couldn't match strides with the winner. SEARCHFORTHETRUTH broke a step slowly and was a bit crowded at the start, raced outside, found his best stride late and was gaining ground. MEDIA CITY raced inside within striking distance and lacked the needed late response. LORD ROBYN failed to threaten in an even effort. RANGER JOE was not a factor. MR CHARLYPOTATOES flashed speed, dropped back and was not urged in the stretch.
