MAROZI set the pace inside and drew clear on the turn then responded to urging through the lane and maintained a safe margin. BEARSTORM lunged out slightly at the start, lodged a three wide bid turning for home and was second best. ARMORED TRUCK race near the rail on the turn, moved out entering the lane and got the show at the wire. CRITICAL RESPONSE saved ground to the lane, raced between rivals passing the eighth pole and lacked the needed late response. COURTING SEATTLE never far back and off the inside on the turn, lacked a stretch bid. A BLACK THORN prompted the early issue, chased on the turn and weakened in the drive. BEFORE THE PROM saved ground and lacked a rally. AGENT DUDLEY trailed and outside turning for home, lacked a bid.
