ACURE FOR GERI stalked the pace for a half mile, closed towards the leaders mid way through the turn, bid six wide to the top of the lane, and proved best the final furlong. JULES JOY pressed second rated evenly throughout, but proved no match for ACURE FOR GERI in deep stretch. JESTALOVER unhurried for the half, rallied late in the turn, shifted to the rail in the upper stretch, and finished evenly in the last eighth. FIRST PRINTING last for the half, rallied moderately down the stretch, but found best stride late to improve. SPENCER'S GIRL posted an even effort, but lacked the needed rally down the lane. DARE EMILY was not a factor. DREAM ANGEL showed brief speed only. PERFECT ANGEL set the pace under pressure for six furlongs before coming up empty in the drive. .
