RED NECK BILL stumbled badly at the start, raced four wide entering the lane and bested the rest. LOTS OF LUCK came out some at the start, raced near the inside passing the quarter pole and lacked the needed stretch response. RUM AND EARL chased early, raced along the inside turning for home and weakened in the drive. BRAT CAT raced four wide into the turn, chased and tired in the drive. MONTEGO MAX came in some at the start, dropped back early, raced five wide turning for home and lacked a rally. MR BROWN COW three wide into the turn, chased between foes and weakened through the lane. GENERAL CONFUSION lacked a response. YO JACOB pressed early, saved ground and weakened.
