Footnotes

SAINTLY AURA showed good early speed, fell back and dropped inside, closed steadily through traffic and got up at the wire. SOCRITICAL raced between horses to the turn, dueled through the stretch, had a head in front late and was caught. BULL TIME lagged outside, went six wide entering the stretch, closed willingly, was gaining fast late and got up late for show. STAR OF THE DIA vied inside to the final strides and yielded grudgingly. MOSES ON THE MESA vied five across to the turn, dropped back and finished evenly. LIVIN' LOVIN' MAN vied four wide between horses to the turn and gave way. AWFULLY LUCKY dropped back early to trail the field and passed a tiring rival. BROTHER CHARLIE vied between horses to the turn and stopped.
