FUSSY PLAYGIRL set the pace from the outset, held the lead gamely under pressure, was headed at the eighth pole, came back outside rival, and was just up in a well contested drive. ANNIE'S BOU PEEP pressured the pace second rated heads apart for seven furlongs, took the lead at the furlong marker, but was outfinished in the final yards while posting a game try. HARTSVILLE raced unhurried the opening half mile, closed up mid way around the final turn, rallied six wide to the top of the lane, then posted a good closing effort for third. RELATIVE SHADE (GB) ranged forwardly down the backstretch, closed the gap to the pace through the far turn, lacked room nearing the top of the lane, shifted out to clear going while making a bid to third at the eighth pole, finished evenly, but was caught for that position in the last strides to the line. JAZZN bid along the inside at the quarter pole, angled out once straightened for the drive, then offered a mild late rally to improve position. NEW RIVER BELLE failed to impact the outcome, but passed tiring rivals in the stretch. PALERMO (MEX) stumbled at the start, pressed the pace for three quarters of a mile, but came up empty in the drive to the wire. DOWNHOME DOLLY was through after the half.
