PROFOUND SECRET dropped back at the start, rated patiently down the backstretch, closed up entering the turn, rallied sharply along the inside at the five sixteenths marker, came belatedly into the stretch, split rivals at three sixteenths, raced even to the pace at the eighth pole, then steadily gained advantage going to the wire without late threat under a smart ride. HANGONSLEWPHYHANGON, unhurried after the break, closed up going into the turn, rallied inside at the five sixteenths mark, was kept to task on the rail entering the stretch, advanced to second at the furlong marker, dueled for the runner up placing, and held racing position boldly to the wire. THATSUSINTEOLBEAN stalked the pace from the start, rallied sharply into the lane, took the lead briefly coming to the eighth pole, but gave way in the final yards. FREESPOOL vied on the pace from the outset, gained advantage from the outside in the deep turn, took the lead to the head of the stretch, but weakened in the drive. G MALLEAH raced evenly throughout while posting a good, trying effort. IZA REDHEAD was outrun, but managed to pass tiring pace horses in the stretch. BETTER CHOICE, off well from the gate, steadily retreated to the finish line. BAY RUNNER, fractious in the gate, was hustled to the pace, dueled for a half mile, stopped, and was eased in the stretch.
