LESSON IN DECEIT was unhurried early, bid seven wide, closed steadily and got up in the final strides. CHAPLAIN was taken back at the start to be unhurried early, bid eight wide, closed willingly and got up in the final strides for place. RULE BY FORCE pressed the pace, bid willingly, assumed command past the sixteenth pole, was outclosed and lost position late. TWIN SPARKS moved up between horses to vie, drew clear on the turn, led past the sixteenth pole and yielded grudgingly. GOIN' DANCIN stalked inside, awaited room on the turn, bid willingly once clear but didn't have enough late. GREEN SECRET raced mid pack, failed to rally and did not threaten. KIND REGARDS broke out, was hustled along to set the pace to the turn and stopped. SEE YA LATER SLEW was through early, eased and walked off.
