LAYOVER IN SEATTLE trailed and in the three path into the lane, finished well from the outside. OH MEXICO in close entering the clubhouse turn, saved ground to the lane, eased out and battled for command late then was outfinished by the top one. RESIST set the early pace inside, vied for the lead turning for home and stayed on while not good enough. BULL TIME prompted the issue then vied for the lead between rivals on the final turn, continued to battle between foes to deep stretch and weakened. TEANCUM steadied slightly on the clubhouse turn, moved up between rivals on the backstretch, bid for the lead three deep on the final turn and weakened late. FAR TO REACH hung a bit wide into the clubhouse turn, moved inward and saved ground rounding the final turn and lacked the needed rally. WAR TRADER got out some into the first turn, chased four wide on the backstretch and weakened.
