SHEMYA REEF was slow early while racing outside, swung wide entering the stretch, closed steadily and got up at the wire. BAIL OUT MOM set a pressured pace, responded when challenged on the turn, dueled past the sixteenth pole, inched away and was caught at the wire. DEE STORM pressed the pace inside, fell back into the turn, came again to threaten but didn't have enough late. BERRY VALID showed good early speed while racing near the rail, was in tight quarters near the half pole, bid five wide, closed well and gained late. FUNKY CHANTEAL saved ground, bid along the rail on the turn and finished well to narrow the gap. PURPLE HAYS pressed the pace, challenged for the lead on the turn, dueled past the sixteenth pole and faltered. XSTRANSPORTATION was not a factor. ARIAT GOLD showed speed to the turn and gave way.
