SEATTLE MEMO showed the way to the lane and drew off, a driving winner. CERTAINLY CERTAIN always a factor, was second best while jumping track marks nearing the wire. CASH RECEIPT fractious in the gate, lodged a wide bid on the final turn and lacked the needed stretch response. HECTOR bumped leaving the gate, raced along the inside into the far turn and lacked the needed bid. PREACHER'S THREAT forced out at the start, raced forwardly placed into the far turn and tired in the drive. I'MARAINBOWRIDER saved ground and lacked a rally. NO WAY JOSE pressed early, weakened on the final turn then was eased across the wire and vanned off.
