Footnotes

THE KINDED unhurried at the start, chased the contested pace rated clearly in mid pack, closed up through the turn, rallied after the quarter pole, angled out at three sixteenths, and was the best horse in the stretch. SINGING LITE stalked the pace from the break, closed up from between horses at the three eighths, rallied into the stretch, dueled with the eventual winner down the lane, came to the sixteenth pole in tight quarters, then gave way going to the wire. A jockey's claim of foul for impeding position in the stretch run against the rider of THE KINDED was subsequently disallowed. BRIAN'S BLACKPEARL set the pace from the gate, lacked the needed late response in the drive, but posted an overall good pace effort. BALBOA PARK closed up through the turn, and offered a mild rally in the stretch. DOUBLE FLYIGHT raced evenly through the turn to the wire. PALERMO (MEX) passed tired horses in the stretch. HIGH PROMISE prompted the pace from the outset, then retreated through the stretch. STRATTER was outrun. MANOOMIN was no factor. BROADWAY'S PET vied on the pace for a half mile, then stopped in the stretch.
