HI HO CAHILL vied for the lead while five deep into the turn, dueled for command through the stretch then edged clear late. TRIBAL WARRIOR vied for the lead inside a five-horse spread into the turn, then dueled with the winner to deep stretch and gave ground grudgingly late. LOUIE TRE was not far back in the run to the turn, saved ground into the stretch then lacked a solid bid. BARBARIC vied for the lead while three wide to the stretch then weakened. BOB JILA vied for the early lead outside, stayed in contention into the stretch and weakened. SPECTACULARTOP fell back some into the turn, was six wide into the stretch and lacked any bid. FREE TO MOVE fell back some after the start, was four wide into the stretch then wasn't a serious threat. SIDEWALK SINGER stumbled slightly at the break then was four deep and between foes vying for the lead and tired in the stretch.
