Footnotes

BIT OF SUNSHINE was six wide on the turn, remained six wide into the stretch, lodged his bid in upper stretch and drew clear late. ALMOSTDIDNOTHAPPEN moved between foes into the turn, lodged his bid at the top of the stretch, took a short lead and still lead inside the sixteenth marker then held the place. NAE DOOT eased out nearing the stretch, was four wide and lodged his bid then finished well between foes. PERKINSVILLE set the early pace, responded and vied for command to deep stretch then weakened late. WICKED BUCK raced between foes near the half-mile pole, took the three path on the turn, was five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late response. TALYOR vied for the early lead along the rail then fell back some into the turn and lacked a stretch response. WINSLOSSESNLESSONS raced inside throughout and lacked a bid. ROCKY RASCAL vied for the lead while between foes then weakened. LUVS A COURTING raced five wide throughout and tired. DR. RIZZ raced five to six wide throughout and was not a factor.
