HOPETOWN HERO moved up outside on the turn, chased and prevailed at the wire. HOBGOBLIN moved to the front on the turn, raced just off the rail into the stretch, drew clear then just failed. CORY'S KING between rivals entering the turn, was carried five wide into the lane and earned the show. UTAH ROCKET chased early, got out on the turn and raced four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed stretch response. GOOD BAD BOY saved ground and lacked the needed rally. OJOS DE ORO broke a bit awkwardly, saved ground and lacked a bid. CAPERS TOWN raced outside on the turn and tired. CRAFTY ALEX set the early pace, saved ground and tired through the lane.
