ROUGH SHOT was well placed early, moved between foes inside the quarter pole, lodged his bid at the top of the stretch and drew clear the final furlong. FIGHTING CITY HALL was three wide in the second flight down the backstretch, lodged his bid nearing the quarter pole then was no match for the winner late while second best. YODEL ME HOME was well placed down the backstretch, raced between foes into the stretch then weakened some the final furlong. SAINT BARR settled after the start, was six wide into the stretch then lacked a solid late bid. STRONG SUGGESTION was a bit sluggish at the start, took the two path on the turn, moved to the rail a furlong out then lacked a bid. MYSTIC MAZE took the three path on the turn, was four wide into the stretch and didn't seriously threaten. FAMOUS FLASH raced five wide much of the way and tired. OH LORD was never in contention. BOLD BIG AL sprinted clear and set the pace to nearing the quarter pole, offered little resistance once headed and tired in the drive.
