Footnotes

NEVERMINDME broke best to quickly show on the lead, increased advantage going into the turn, held a two and a half length margin at the eighth pole, and raced to the wire without threat. FESTEGA stalked third behind the pace alongside a rival for a half mile, rallied nearing the top of the lane, chased the winner with good even effort down the lane, was no match, but ended well clear for the place position at the wire. TUKWILAMINA held off the pace for a half mile, closed the gap to the leaders at mid turn, moved up entering the stretch, bid into third at the furlong marker, and finished willingly while well beaten by the top two horses. CLASSY CON positioned forwardly down the backstretch, bid into second after racing a half, held position to the late turn, but weakened in the drive to the wire. PLAY THE NUMBERS failed to impact the outcome, but managed to pass tiring rivals in the run down the lane. PARTY LACE showed speed for a half mile before coming up empty in the drive. RACHEL TWO SOCKS offered brief speed only before tiring.
