Footnotes

GATLING GUN stumbled at the start, moved up early to reach the front, drew clear approaching the far turn then held well through the stretch run. MR. CACHT (ARG) vied early then prompted the pace, was just off the inside turning for home and finished willingly. MAJOR MAGIC saved ground while well placed, chased through the lane but needed more. FLY'N LION near the inside to the lane, was gaining late outside rivals. CALLINGAHARDTEN saved ground to the lane and needed more. SIR SEARSUCKER broke out and lacked a rally. RED PIRATE bumped between rivals at the start, raced a bit headstrong and was up close three wide on the backstretch, remained a factor into the lane and weakened. FARMER GILES (IRE) three wide into the far turn, was in the five path entering the lane and had no rally. ARRAIGNMENT chased early four wide and tired.
