IRONMAN DEHERE pressed the pace inside, challenged for the lead on the second turn, dueled past the eighth pole and inched away. RESOLVE set the pace, responded when challenged on the far turn to duel for the lead and was outfinished in a game effort. OUR COLORS raced mid pack, awaited room on the far turn, angled out at the top of the stretch and closed well. BIG BAD JUAN raced close to the pace, steadied behind a tiring rival on the turn, bumped TOP HIT entering the stretch and lacked the needed late response. TOP HIT was never far off the pace, rallied between horses leaving the far turn, bumped and hung late. EL CHORRO was in tight at the top of the stretch and lacked a late rally. DISCONNECT bore out on the first turn and failed to threaten in a wide trip. PROHIBITIVE lacked a rally. CLEARITE showed speed to the second turn and faded from contention. LADY'S LIL' RINGER was never far off the pace, loomed a threat at the top of the stretch and gave way. D D STORMY stalked the pace to the second turn and stopped.
