ROCKY'S OFFICER was steadied at the start, saved ground mid pack, angled out on the second turn, bid six wide at the top of the lane, closed steadily and got up near the wire. AWESOME WONDERER was never far off the pace while racing outside, rallied four wide on the turn, dueled for the lead, began to inch away near the sixteenth pole and was caught near the wire. T J AND COMPANY stalked inside, challenged along the rail on the turn, dueled for the lead and faltered near the sixteenth pole. GET MY FIX was unhurried early, saved ground, angled out in the upper stretch, bid five wide to loom a threat but didn't have enough late. I'M THE GOLD stalked the pace, challenged three across on the turn, dueled to mid stretch and was unable to sustain his bid. PISA PLAYBOY was not a factor. ROCKY RASCAL set the pace to the second turn, tired and gave way. ROZYS SCENARIO had the rider lose his irons.
