NORDIC WIND prompted the early issue, moved closer on the final turn and battled through the lane then proved best. STORMY HIGHLAND saved ground while setting the pace, responded when asked then held well while unable to contain the top one. OUACHITA CREEK never far back, saved ground and gained some in the drive. DEANOGUSKA well placed while saving ground, eased off the inside for the drive and lacked the needed response. BUCK'S BLUSH close up early and between rivals on the backstretch, raced outside a rival on the final turn and lacked the needed bid. JUST BILL JIM never far back and near the inside turning for home, lacked a stretch response. DANCEAFUNNYMILE trailed to the top of the lane, raced along the inside and lacked the needed rally. SHARP SOUNDS was steadied slightly entering the far turn then offered little thereafter.
