TRIFECTA PHIL broke alertly, vied for the early lead, raced outside a rival on the turn and held gamely to the wire. BIG GAME PLAN brushed then bumped leaving the gate, advanced near the inside on the turn and was best of the rest. TEST BOY broke in some then in tight between rivals leaving the gate, trailed and offered a belated gain. GOIN' DANCIN raced five wide passing the quarter pole and lacked the needed response. SNOWBOUND WARRIOR chased early, saved ground and weakened. CAPT. JOE BLOW vied for the lead, saved ground on the turn and tired in the drive. SNEAKIN BY came in early, drifted wide into the stretch and weakened.
