BROADWAY EMPIRE bumped at the start, showed the way to the lane and drew off under some mild intermittent hand urging. BRENDA'S BAR broke awkwardly and outward, raced outside on the turn and finished steadily to be clear for the place. DR. WATSON up close early, chased on the turn and weakened in the drive. TOC THIS WAY prompted early, saved ground and tired through the lane. RONDO HONDO unseated the rider at the gate and was loose in the chute briefly, was loaded without the jockey, raced near the inside on the turn and lacked a bid. TIZ WORTH BELIEVIN was steadied leaving the gate when attempting to duck in, raced outside into the turn, was five wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. FOX BEGONE bumped at the start, saved ground on the turn and lacked a bid.
