IRENES JACKPOT up close early while three wide, challenged for the lead on the final turn, dueled outside a rival into the lane and finished gamely while edging clear late. GHOST N YOUR HEART three wide and between rivals entering the far turn, raced just off the inside passing the quarter pole and was angled out some for the drive then finished gamely. MISS BUXLEY four deep into the far turn, edged closer three wide on the final turn then lacked the needed stretch response. IT'S D'LOVELY bobbled at the start, saved ground early and was just off the inside leaving the backstretch, moved out for the drive and offered a mild late response. SAPPHIREDIAMONDS moved up along the inside approaching the far turn, raced just off the inside turning for home and lacked the needed stretch bid. LOS LUNAS prompted the early issue, moved to the front on the final turn, battled into midstretch then weakened late. TRICK SKATE set the early pace, saved ground and weakened in the drive.
