SOMMELIER SMARTY broke slowly, saved ground into the far turn, eased out while lodging a bid on the final bend and raced in the four path entering the lane then finished gamely to prevail. DANCE CHIEF dueled for the lead outside a rival, edged clear in the stretch then continued on gamely while unable to resist the top one. CIMMARON KID well placed while saving ground, bid along the rail in the lane and finished willingly while needing more. BEAR FAMOUS TRIP jumped a shadow nearing the end of the chute while vying for command, continued to duel from along the inside and weakened in the drive. CARNERA in good position and between rivals to the far turn, chased and lacked the needed stretch response. MR SHANE THE PAIN saved ground early and just off the inside leaving the backstretch, lacked a rally. FORCHTENBERG was three wide into the far turn and lacked a bid. FAR FLUNG raced well placed three wide to the end of the backstretch and tired.
