CAPT. JOE BLOW vied two across to the turn, drew off for a long lead and held safely under mild urging. RANGER JOE saved ground to the stretch, eased out for the drive, offered a mild bid and finished second best. TAXI FLEET was slow early, bid along the rail on the turn and got up for show. CLAY W. WOODSTOCK went five wide leaving the turn and was outfinished for third despite steady left handed urging. JOHNNY'S TIME raced outside, went four wide into the stretch, had little left and faded from contention. FRISKY RICKY vied inside to the turn and stopped. HIGH STANDARDS was eased and walked off.
