TOMMY AND BUSTER set the pace inside, showed the way to the lane and gradually drew out through the final furlong. GUMMY RUNNER lodged a bid inside on the final turn, chased then was no match to the top one while second best. WHO'S RALPH broke in some, saved ground and lacked the needed bid. KEY LARGO lunged out at the start, trailed and raced six wide into the lane then offered a stretch gain. MANSIONES five wide early, was angled inward on the clubhouse turn, raced along the inside turning for home and lacked the needed late response. WALLY VAN prompted the early issue and tired through the lane. RATON PASS raced five wide and lacked a rally. DIPLO raced up close early while three wide then tired through the stretch. SPECTACULARTOP chased to the far turn and weakened then gave way through the lane and was distanced late.
