LITTLE GYPSY lagged early, rallied five wide leaving the turn, closed willingly under left handed urging, got up late and won going away. OAK FLAT set the pace with a clear lead to late stretch, was outclosed but held for second. BACKSTRETCH GINGEE chased the pace, lacked the needed late response but held for show. MISS DOW JONES stalked off the rail, bid, hung and was outfinished for third. KOOKY KELLY was away well, dropped back to trail and finished well to narrow the gap. TABLE MESA lagged, got through along the rail entering the stretch but failed to rally. SPICE SPICE BABY raced between horses, showed speed to the turn and gave way.
