LIVING WORD led throughout and held well in a driving finish. ELUSIVE SCHEMES saved ground while never far off the pace, eased out on the turn, challenged for the lead, went willingly to the wire but couldn't match strides with the winner. FUNNY JUSTICE was unhurried early, saved ground, got through along the rail entering the stretch but lacked a late response. WESTERN ACT was never far back, went four wide leaving the turn, had nothing left for the drive and hung in the lane. DARK VADER pressed the pace three across to the second turn and tired. BOLD BENGIE pressed the pace while racing between horses and tired into the second turn.
