JUST JEBICAH pressed the pace two wide, swung out entering the stretch, closed steadily to get up late and was all out at the wire. POSITIVE FORCE held a good position, rallied four wide leaving the turn, went willingly to the wire and was outfinished. WHITE SPAR was never far off the pace, bid two wide between horses and got up late for show. TENFOLD set a pressured pace to deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. RANGER JOE raced inside to the turn, went five wide in the drive, bid but didn't have enough late. CHAPLAIN trailed far back, offered a mild bid only and improved position. MUTAK GOLD raced in the back, lacked a rally and was not a threat. UNCANNY YODEL was not a factor.
