SWISS SKI lodged a four wide bid on the turn, drifted in some late and finished gamely to prevail. ESPRESSO SPRINGS moved up inside through the opening stages to reach the front, showed the way to the lane and edged away some in midstretch then yielded late. FATHER JONES three wide turning for home, chased and raced in a bit close late between rivals and needed more. IRON FORTITUDE moved out turning for home and offered a late gain. QUICK SCORE broke slowly, raced five wide turning for home and lacked the needed rally. GOIN' DANCIN broke alertly to lead through the opening stages then prompted the issue and weakened in the drive. CAMP VERDE well placed early and three wide passing the quarter pole, tired in the drive. TRUCKIN in good position early, saved ground on the turn and weakened.
