PISTOIA raced between rivals entering the lane while just off the inside, challenged for the lead a furlong out then narrowly proved best. MIXED INTENT set the pace inside, responded willingly in the drive and yielded grudgingly. LIL STORMIN TORIE stumbled at the start and vied through the early stages, saved ground into the lane, eased off the inside at the eighth pole and needed more. STYLEFREE chased and four wide into the stretch, lacked the needed closing response. LOUISE IS A GA GA chased four wide on the turn, raced in the six path entering the stretch and weakened. REASON TO CRY saved ground and lacked a bid. GRIN N WAGER IT chased three wide and tired through the lane.
