BOREALIS WAY ran off behind the gate, raced close to the pace outside, assumed command at the top of the lane, drew off and was ridden out. BENNY'S BENCHMARK was slow early, went seven wide leaving the turn, closed to earn place but was no match for the winner. HUMAN ERASER raced mid pack, angled out on the turn, went five wide entering the stretch, offered a mild bid and got up for show. IMA ROYAL PRINCE broke out, chased the pace, weakened in the drive and faded through the stretch. BOJAX was hustled along to set the pace, weakened in the drive and gave way. RUN FOR MILES saved ground, angled out on the turn, went six wide into the stretch and failed to rally. JUGADOR trailed the field, closed well inside, ran up behind horses and was checked near the wire.
