GRACIAS moved to the front along the inside on the turn and gradually edged away through the final furlong, a driving winner. JACKSONVILLE bid on the turn and chased turning for home then was no match while holding the place. STOPIN MEMO four wide on the turn, raced between foes in upper stretch and was gaining late. HOT ON TOP trailed early, advanced between rivals on the turn, was near the inside through the lane and drifted in some leaving the furlong grounds then lacked the needed late response. QUICK WAMPUM saved ground and lacked the needed response while in a bit close briefly inside the eighth pole. THREETIMESA WONDER chased three wide on the turn, was in the six path entering the stretch and tired. HINDU KUSH raced three wide into the lane and lacked a rally. SUSAN'S LUCK set the early pace, raced five wide into the stretch and weakened.
