DERIVE broke sharply, vied two across to the turn, drew clear and extended his lead under urging. DANZIP vied inside to the turn, fell back and was all out for place. ABSOLUTELY COOL raced close to the pace between horses, put in a steady effort but couldn't gain ground. JUMP UP AND KISSME lagged outside, went six wide leaving the turn, closed but didn't have enough late. LORD AVALON trailed early, advanced around the turn, bid and hung. MARK OF A WARRIOR raced close to the pace, went five wide leaving the turn, leveled off and faded. TRIP THE GENERAL was slow early, raced inside and lacked a bid under mild urging. BRIARTIC COUNTY was never far off the pace, had nothing left for the drive and faded through the stretch. SONGFOYA pressed the pace inside, gave way into the turn and was not urged through the stretch.
