SLEWS DARK KNIGHT challenged for the lead three wide on the turn, dueled with a rival through midstretch, responded to left handed pressure and edged clear while hand ridden late. SECRET ELEMENT advanced four wide on the turn and finished willingly while second best. REGAL JOURNEY bobbled and broke in to be away awkwardly, raced four wide into the lane and offered a late gain. GOLDEN MINUET broke out, moved up early along the inside and latched the front, set the pace inside and weakened in the drive. ACOLYTE bumped between rivals at the start, raced just off the inside on the turn and lacked a rally. EY SEE DEE SEE in a bit tight at the start, pressed the issue and weakened through the lane. STATELY TOM saved ground and lacked a bid.
