GENERAL HOEDOWN raced four wide on the turn and lacked the needed stretch response. NICKY CREEK vied for the lead inside, raced off the rail into the stretch and tired in the drive. ROYAL REGIMENT was swung wide into the lane and lacked a rally. QUEENS LIGHTING saved ground and lacked a bid.
